

## INQUIRY COMMITTEE RECORD OF DECISION

**FILE NAME: DH0760**

### **FACTS**

On April 10, 2007, the Inquiry Committee resolved to investigate, on its own motion, a registrant who had practiced dental hygiene without professional liability insurance over a two-month period.

Pursuant to section 33 (4) of the *Health Professions Act*, the Committee on its own motion, directed the Registrar of the College to investigate the registrant for contravention of the Act and the College's bylaws.

In response to the investigation, the registrant advised the College that the liability insurance had expired whilst the registrant was in the midst of moving residence and the registrant had forgotten that it was time to renew the insurance.

### **COMMITTEE DECISION**

After investigating the matter the committee resolved, under section 36(1) of the *Act*, to request the registrant not to repeat the conduct of practicing dental hygiene without insurance; to comply with the College's registration requirements at all times; to review the Registrant's Handbook; to complete and submit a Regulation Assessment document as provided by the Registrar.
