ELEMENTS OF COMPLAINT

On October 6, 2014, the CDHBC Inquiry Committee initiated an investigation under s. 33(4)(a) of the *Health Professions Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 183 (the "Act") with respect to issues concerning the Registrant's clinical charting and documentation standards. The Inquiry Committee appointed an inspector to assist with the investigation.

On October 7, 2014, the CDHBC Registrar notified the Registrant of the investigation and requested the Registrant's response to the investigation, in accordance with s. 33(5) of the Act.

The Registrant provided a written response advising of recent improvements made to his/her charting system.

On February 15, 2015, the College received the inspector's report, a copy of which was provided to the Registrant for response.

COMMITTEE DECISION

At the conclusion of the investigation, the Inquiry Committee passed a motion to take no further action in this matter under s. 33(6)(a) of the *Act* as it was satisfied that: (a) s/he had acted proactively to re-evaluate his/her procedures and record-keeping; (b) s/he had made several changes to his/her practice and clinical documentation to address the concerns identified in the inspector's report; and (c) s/he set out further steps that s/he intended to take to ensure proper assessment, diagnosis, treatment and clinical documentation. The Inquiry Committee was satisfied that the Registrant was working to ensure compliance with the terms of a previous consent order that it will be continuing to monitor.
